

MODELS'2007 Workshop Proposal Guidelines

This document provides a guideline which information must be included in a workshop proposal and how the proposal document has to be structured.

The proposal must be submitted via the submission web site (<http://models07-workshop-proposals.uni-paderborn.de/>).

In a first step the following information must be provided via a web site from (“abstract submission”):

- Workshop Title
- Primary Contact (Email)
- Organizers (name / affiliation)
- Abstract:

Then, in a second step (“paper submission”) the proposal has to be submitted as a Postscript or PDF file which adheres to the following structure:

- Workshop Title and Organizers (name / affiliation / Email)
- 1** Motivation
 - 1.1** Objectives
 - 1.2** Intended audience
 - 1.3** Relevance (in particular for the MoDELS community)
 - 1.4** Context (any past events related to your workshop: related conferences, previous workshops, previous sessions, previous implication of the current organizers, etc.)
 - 1.5** Need (comments in favor of your application, if your workshop was at MoDELS'06 or any of the former conferences, why is it useful to run it again?)
 - 2** Organization
 - 2.1** Organizers (name / affiliation / background / related experiences):
 - 2.2** Workshop program committee (indicated as finalized or expected):
 - 2.3** Would you be willing to merge your workshop with other workshops on a similar topic if this was a condition for hosting your workshop at MoDELS?
 - 3** Workshop Format
 - 3.1** Planned deadlines
 - 3.2** Intended paper format (expected submissions, evaluation process, intended publication of accepted papers besides the planned LNCS satellite volume, etc.)
 - 3.3** Intended workshop format (duration, number of presentations, proceedings publication, planned keynotes, etc.)
 - 3.4** How many participants do you expect (please make at least an educated guess)?
 - 3.5** What kind of equipment do you need (data projector, computer, blackboard, etc.)?
 - 4** Additional material
 - 4.1** Workshop Web Page (URL of the draft web page, if one exists)
 - 4.2** Planned Call for Papers for the Workshop (a one page "Call for Papers" that you intend to send out if your workshop is accepted).
